Chuck Stebelton served a second consecutive term as club president in 1980. The weekly meetings were still being held at the old Grand Rapids Public Museum with the exception of the May meeting. This meeting was held at Riverside Park with 17 Corvairs in attendance. According to the minutes of that meeting, this was the largest Corvair turnout at a regular meeting that anybody could remember. Other activities for 1980 included a car show at Eastbrook Mall, a parade of Corvairs at Berlin Raceway during the intermission, and a picnic with the Grand Rapids Antique Car Club. Also, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual WMCC Fall Get Together was held at Douglas Walker Park in October. There were 36 Corvairs on hand for this event. One fun activity was a Corvair parts guessing game. Bruce MacIntosh was the winner by correctly guessing 52 out of 56 parts correctly. Also, at the November meeting, it was suggested by Pat Murphy that the West Michigan Corvair Club should host a CORSA Convention, possibly in 1986.

Tom Lannon was elected president in 1981. The main focus of the club was to put together a bid to host a CORSA Convention to present to the CORSA Board of Directors at the convention in Denver. This included a promotional film about the city of Grand Rapids obtained from the city and pictures of WMCC members with their cars around the Grand Rapids area. Pat Murphy was to presented the bid. There was another Eastbrook Mall show in June and a fall show at Rogers Plaza. Chuck Stebelton presented a tech session on the how-to's of body work during one of the general meetings. Tom and Mark Lannon arranged for the club to tour the GM Diesel Plant for the March general meeting. Other activities included the Coast Guard Parade in Grand Haven and the annual fall color tour. Bob O'Neill donated a great number of parts to the club and a 31-foot trailer was purchased to hold the club's parts.
