### A BLAST FROM THE PAST


I was presented with a couple of catalogs by Dan Konkle at the January meeting. One was a small three page flyer from Eelco. The other was a larger 14-page catalog from Ropal Engineering. Both companies were based in California.

The Eelco catalog had a postmark from 1962 so it is rather old. One page features interior accessories from auxiliary gauges (for \$3.95 each) to shift boots to a cast aluminum console for \$39.95. The second page featured some exterior "dress up" items like headlight grilles (\$11.95 a pair), chrome lug nuts (\$4.95 for a set of four) and chrome hub covers (\$11.95 for a set of four). You could even order a Spyder nameplate for "a very distinctive custom touch" for \$2.50. The third page featured a number of performance items.




The Ropal catalog had no postmark or any indication as to how old it was. I'm guessing that it is from the 1960's since it just features parts for early model Corvairs.

This catalog features a similar assortment of interior and exterior accessories including a center console, auxiliary gauges, a custom steering wheel and quick fill type gas cap.





There was also quite an assortment of high performance parts. Look at this picture of a couple of different carb options.



- Banquet
  - Dave Dykwell is proposing moving the banquet to the Air Zoo from the Gilmore Car Museum
  - There is less risk related to the weather and attendance; banquet would be inside
  - Air Zoo is a lot closer to host hotel
  - o It is more cost effective
  - They will take care of the bar; there will be no need to sell drink tickets ahead of time which was going to be a big headache
  - A vote was taken and the proposal passed (not without some debate however)
- Saturday Car Display
  - Hagerty Insurance is sponsoring the Saturday Car Display
  - They will have a table at the show
  - There was some debate on how to use the sponsorship money; no consensus was reached

- There was also some debate around how the spectators (convention attendees who did not drive a Corvair) are going to be admitted to the Saturday car display; no consensus was reached
- Decision was made to cancel the Futurliner; it doesn't really fit with the 60's theme
- Registration
  - Officially opens with the publication of the April Communique
- Banquet for kids
  - The idea was floated about having a separate banquet/party for the kids
  - Could be cost effective for the parents
  - o Would be a pizza party with some games
  - The big concern would be hiring professional care; we would not be able to pull this off without professional care
  - Probably would not be cost effective for us
- Plans for each area of responsibility were discussed; did not finish
- Next meeting planned for February 12
