# About 700 Corvair Club Members Hold National Rally in GR

By Margaret A. Trimer Although Gali Bouhadiba doesn't speak or understand English very well, he had no problem Friday communicating with hundreds of Americans and Canadians at a convention of Corvair owners.

Equipped with a camera, lots of film and a Corvair baseball cap and T-shirt, Bouhadiba, 65, of Six Fours, France, talked a lot about rear-end engines, maneuverability and Ralph Nader.

"I spent all my budget to come here because I love the U.S.A. and the Corvair," said Bouhadiba, a five-year member of the Corvair Society of America. About 60 other people from southern France belong to the organization that has more than 1,000 members.

Although he has a fancy for the United States, Bouhadiba admits the European flair of the Corvair is what he likes best about the carr


"The Corvair is very much like cars in France," he said. "It drives like a European car, looks like a European car and handles like a European car."

Bouhadiba owns three Corvairs, which he left in France because transporting them was too cost ly.

About 700 club members have gathered in Grand Rapids this

weekend for the national rally. Their Corvairs were on display Friday in the Calder Plaza.

About 1.7 million of the aporty vehicles were manufactured through the 1960s. In 1965, consum-er advocate Ralph Nader based his book, "Unsafe at Any Spee(1" on the Corvair. Nader said the car had "peculiar friskiness" and rearwheel bearing problems that

caused it to spin out of control on

Until the late 1960s, the Corvette was the Corvair's closest competitor in the sports car market, said Tom Lannon, president of the 64-member West Michigan Corvair Club. The car's demise came partly because the Mustang and Camaro hit the market with lower prices

and better marketing, said Lannon, a Grand Rapids resident.

Despite criticism, most of conventioneers agreed the cars and the camaraderie are priceless.
"These cars a lot of fun and they

were so far ahead of their time that cars now are just catching up to them in design," said Michael Moran of Pittsburgh.

"People here are so friendly and I understand all the smiles best," said Bouhadiba, who will return to France on Sunday.

Trophies will be awarded tonight to owners of the top three cars in four different divisions. The cars are judged on how "brilliant they look" and how well they have been preserved.
