Ever since the West Michigan Corvair Club was formed 40 years ago in 1974, we've had one constant: getting out our cars and enjoying them as a group. We still turn heads when we have a big group of them together.

We've had a lot of fun over the years getting together for various activities. We still do the annual Spring Dust Off and the annual fall color tour. Those have been mainstays sine 1974.



In the early years of the club, they enjoyed a lot of picnics, winery tours, and watching videos/films on Corvair topics.

Through the 1980's and the early 1990's the club was very active on the parade circuit. We would be regulars at the Grand Rapids Festival parade, the Grand Haven Coast Guard Festival parade, an various homecoming parades just to name a few. We haven't been as active for the last few years other than the Douglas Oktoberfest parade in 2010 and 2012. We also paraded around Berlin Raceway between races

a number of times in the 1970's, 1980's and 2000's.

Other highlights include trips to GM plants in Grand Rapids and Lansing, a trip to the Henry Ford Museum, a trip to the Auburn Cord Duesenberg Museum, and a trip to the Corvair Ranch in Gettysburg, PA.

We hosted the CORSA International Convention in 1986 in Grand Rapids and 2013 in Kalamazoo.

We started an annual car show in May of 1997 and even though it has moved around the calendar, it still goes on to this day.

 - The event would be on Memorial Day weekend and a lot of people have other plans for that weekend


- o Turnout would be low
