A Look Back

It was 17 years ago in May that we held an event for the first time and we've been holding it every year since.

On May 17, 1997 we held the 1st Annual WMCC Car Display and Swap Meet. The idea for the event came about because the popular show in Bryan, Ohio was not going to happen that year. We thought it would be a good idea to capitalize on the "opening" in the schedule.



The venue for that first event was a pie-wedge shaped piece of property on M-43 in Bangor that was owned by Restorations Plus. There were 23 Corvairs there as well as a few parts vendors. All years except 1960 and 1969 were represented. Along with WMCC, the following clubs were there: Detroit, Michiana, and Mad Anthony.



It appears that we didn't have any people's choice

awards until the second year of the show. That was when we added an award for each class: early open, early closed, forward control, late open, and late closed. Restorations Plus hosted us again that second year.

For our 25th Anniversary in 1999, we moved the event west on M-43 to the Don Cleveland Antique Auto Museum & Antique Shop. We continued to have it in May but it was moved to the end of the month. There were 20 Corvairs in attendance that year. However, the swap meet portion was losing steam as there was only one parts vendor and one toy vendor there. We stayed at this venue until 2001.



In 2002, we moved to the Gilmore Car Museum. We held the event in conjunction with the Red Barns Spectacular which is the first Saturday in August. Attendance remained steady with the Corvairs numbering in the high teens to low 20's until last year. We only had nine Corvairs in 2013; this was probably due to the convention being there just two weeks before.



This event is on the move again for 2014. The venue of the Gilmore Car Museum is staying the same, just the date is changing. We are now holding it in conjunction with the All Air Cooled Show on June 14. This event is a lot less crowded than the Red Barns Spectacular and should allow more enjoyment of the museum.
