Overnight Trip Update

Great news for those planning on participating in our overnight Traverse City Tour, we've managed to make the reservation process **EASIER** and the room rate **CHEAPER**.

West Michigan Corvair Club has a limited number of (10) rooms reserved in a Block – (7) King and (3) Double-Queen. These rooms will be released as members call-in their reservations. First call first reserved. Any unreserved rooms will be released from the CORVAIR Block after 7/31. So, you'll want to call before the end of the month. We've also made special arrangements for an unheard of Traverse City room-rate of only \$84 plus tax, title and transfer when we book the entire block. Similar places run \$140 and more!

If you plan to participate, all you need to do is call the hotel directly. Tell them you wish to reserve a room under the CORVAIR BLOCK and supply them with your credit card. This will guarantee your room without a deposit. And, you can cancel your reservation without a fee if you call them within 48 hours of arrival. How could it be any easier or cheaper?

To summarize, we'll be visiting TRAVERSE CITY on September 19 & 20. We'll rally at Fricano's on Alpine for coffee & donuts then embark on a leisurely drive up north on secondary paved roads. Once there, we'll have a group lunch at DON'S Classic Car Drive-In famous for burgers, clam baskets, grilled cheese on rye, curly fries and *Cherry Shakes*. After lunch, we'll check-in to our hotel just a few blocks away. At 1:30pm, we'll rally for our afternoon WINE TOUR along scenic Mission Point Peninsula – with several vineyards to choose from. After returning back to the hotel for a breather we'll follow that up with a later Group Dinner at either the Apache Trout Grill or Boone's at Long Lake. Sampling several micro-breweries downtown after dinner is optional.

On Sunday morning we'll have a Free Continental Breakfast. Or, you can hit the Sunrise Café close by or the original Flap Jack Shack (same owners). Finishing our Tour, we'll rally at the hotel at 10:30am (check-out) for a drive up M-22 to Sutton's Bay and over to Fishtown. There, you're "on your own" to enjoy unique shops, more tasting rooms, buy the best smoked fish or fudge and maybe have an ice cream cone.
