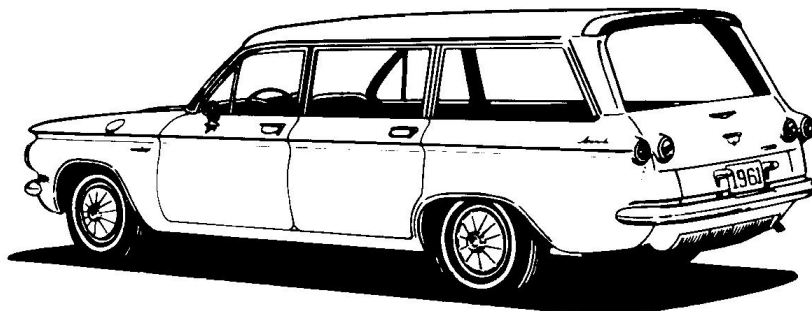

### September Meeting

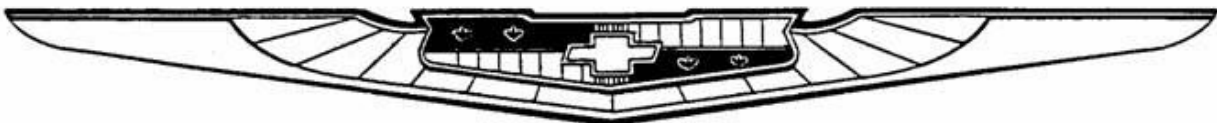
- Originally planned for September 15 at Peppino's in Allendale
