Color Tour Route

Here is the route we will be taking for the color tour on October 17.

Meet: Rally at FRICANO's (Alpine) at 8:30am for Donuts & Cider – depart 9:00am

Route: First Leg will have us traveling northwest to Pentwater and Ludington along the lakeshore. We'll stop for lunch in Ludington. Second Leg will have us traveling East to Evert/Sears down to Six Lakes and across US131 to Newaygo. Approximately 225 miles.

FIRST LEG:

Turn RIGHT (North) on M37 to round-about then LEFT (WEST) on M-46.

Turn RIGHT (North) on CR B31/S. Maple Rd thru Reeman on 120 North

Turn LEFT (West) on CR B86/M82 to Montague straight to CR B15

Turn RIGHT (North) on CR B15 to Pentwater

Turn LEFT (North) to BR31 thru town toward Ludington to US10

Turn LEFT (West) on US10 to town and to Lunch;

Note: Reservations made for OUTSIDE seating

SECOND LEG:

Leave Ludington going back EAST on US10/31 to US10

Continue traveling EAST along US10 to Evert/Sears to M66

Turn RIGHT (South) on M66 down to Six Lakes

Turn RIGHT (West) on M46 to US131 going South to first exit M82

Turn RIGHT (West) on M82 to Newaygo.

Tour Done. You can turn Right (north) on M37 to Newaygo OR

Turn Left (south) on M37 to drive back to GR.
