I Didn't Miss This One!—The 2024 Lowrider Super Show

From time to time in this space I'd like to relate car stories that I find interesting. Here's my latest tale:

Hi All-- In an earlier issue of this newsletter I professed my newfound admiration for the culture of lowrider cars. I noted that I'd be sure to attend the 2024 Lowrider Super Show here in town. Well, I now can say I walked the complete expanse of this year's show at the Convention Center. I attended the show with my true love, Anne Mae as well as our daughter, Sara and a young friend, Alex. Before I describe this spectacular show I think you might be interested to know that in addition to me seeing lowriders in the southwest and west I ran into a New Mexico lowrider in non-other than the venerable Smithsonian Museum in Washington D.C. A display of New Mexico objects included a stellar lowrider with all it's trophies. Check it out in in this picture. Thinking about this I realized that whoever owns that ride should feel conflicted. The display I witnessed on June 2 was a lot bigger than the lone car at the Smithsonian. I would estimate between 2-3 thousand cars were on display (Just kidding).
