YOUR CHEVROLET VEHICLE IS BACKED BY A 24-MONTH or 24,000-MILE WARRANTY

The warranty appears in full in this Owner Protection Plan Booklet

The warranty provides that any part or parts (except tires or tubes) which are defective in material or workmanship and which are returned to the authorized selling dealer or to another authorized Chevrolet dealer, within 24 months or 24,000 miles, whichever comes first, from the date of delivery to the original retail purchaser by the authorized selling dealer, will be repaired or replaced at the Manufacturer's option, including labor for such repair or replacement if made at such dealer's place of business, providing the repair or replacement is not due to misuse, negligence or accident, or which has been repaired or altered outside an authorized Chevrolet dealership so as, in the opinion of the Manufacturer, to adversely affect its performance and reliability.

Normal maintenance services and replacement of service items such as the following are not covered by the warranty and are the responsibility of the owner:

MAINTENANCE SERVICES: Periodic lubrication and adjustments due to normal usage or which become necessary to maintain quiet operation Front wheel alignment Wheel balance Tire rotation Brake and clutch adjustments Engine oil change Transmission oil change and adjustments Engine tune-up and electrical system checks

Fuel system cleaning

Maintenance Services: (Cont'd) Positive crankcase ventilation valve cleaning Drive belt adjustments

REPLACEMENT ITEMS installed as part of Maintenance Service: Brake and clutch lining due to wear Spark plugs, ignition points and filters Air cleaner service

NORMAL DETERIORATION OF:

Paint, chrome, convertible top and interior trim due to wear and exposure

There are no warranties, expressed or implied, made by either the Dealer or the Manufacturer on new Chevrolet motor vehicles except the Manufacturer's Warranty against defects in material and workmanship set out below:

New Vehicle Warranty

Chevrolet Motor Division of General Motors Corporation, as Maoufacturer, warrants each new motor vehicle and chassis including all equipment and accessories thereon (except tires and tubes), manufactured or supplied by Chevrolet Motor Division and delivered to the original retail purchaser by an authorized Chevrolet Dealer, to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use and service; Chevrolet Motor Division's obligation under this warranty being limited to repairing or replacing at its option any part or parts thereof which shall, within twenty-four (24) months after delivery of such vehicle or chassis to the original retail purchaser or before such vehicle or chassis has been driven twenty-four thousand (24,000) miles, whichever event shall first occur, be returned to an authorized Chevrolet Dealer at such Dealer's place of business and which examination shall disclose to Mannfacturer's satisfaction to have been thus defective. The repair or replacement of defective parts under this warranty will be made by such dealer without charge for parts, and if made at such Dealer's place of business, without charge for labor.

The provisions of this warranty shall not apply to any Chevrolet motor vehicle or chassis which has been subject to misuse, negligence or accident, or which shall have been repaired or altered outside of an authorized Chevrolet dealership in any way so as, in the judgment of Manufacturer, to affect adversely its performance and reliability, nor to normal maintenance services (such as engine tune up, fuel system cleaning and wheel, brake and clutch adjustments) and the replacement of service items (such as spark plugs, ignition points, filters and brake and clutch lining) made in connection with such services, nor to normal deterioration of soft trim and appearance items due to wear and exposure.

This warranty is expressly in lieu of any other warranties, expressed or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, and of any other obligations or liability on the part of the Manufacturer, and Chevrolet Motor Division neither assumes nor authorizes any other person to assume for it any other liability in connection with such motor vehicle or chassis.

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REGARDING THE USE OF TRAILERS WITH YOUR CHEVROLET ...

When a trailer is attached to a car, the car becomes not only a load-carrying vehicle, but a load-pulling vehicle. The demands of this type of operation are very different from those for which the automobile is primarily designed and may affect certain standard-equipment components, such as springs, tires, brakes, cooling system, lighting and steering. However, careful driving practices and the use of heavy-duty options should satisfy the requirements of trailer hauling.

POLICY ON OWNER SERVICE

1. DELIVERY—To help you secure moximum satisfaction with your new Chevrolet, it has been inspected and conditioned by the selling dealer according to the pre-delivery inspectian schedule recommended by Chevrolet.

2. VERIFICATION VOUCHER—When warranty service is performed on your vehicle by a Chevrolet dealer, you will be required to sign and surrender to such dealer one of the Verification Vouchers included in this baoklet. If such Verification Vouchers have been used or lost, notify such dealer. Prior use ar loss of Verification Vouchers does not in any way vaid or affect the New Vehicle Warranty. While services under the New Vehicle Warranty may be furnished by any authorized Chevrolet dealer, it is recommended that warranty services be performed by the Chevrolet dealer issuing this booklet and from whom you purchased your vehicle, because of his continued and personal interest in you.

3. OWNER RESPONSIBILITY—Proper maintenance and care of your Chevrolet will help you achieve lower over-all operating costs. Also regular and proper maintenance of your Chevrolet by competent technicians will help you avoid conditions arising from neglect which are not covered by the New Vehicle Warronty. In this connection maintenance services should be performed in accordance with the "Guardian Maintenance" service recommendations contained in this booklet.

4. TOURING OR CHANGE OF RESIDENCE—When touring or in the event you move, any outhorized Chevrolet dealer in the U. S. or Canada will hanor the New Vehicle Worranty.

5. DESIGN CHANGES—The Manufacturer reserves the right to make changes in design or add any improvements on motor vehicles and chassis at any time without incurring any obligation to install same on motor vehicles and chassis previously purchased. Dealer reserves a similar right.

6. PAINT AND OTHER APPEARANCE ITEMS—Imperfection in paint, trim or other appearance items is normally apparent and corrected during new vehicle pre-delivery conditioning. Normal deterioration due to use and exposure is not covered by warranty. For your protection, you are urged to immediately call any imperfection to the attention of your selling dealer, so that he may make any necessary correction.

7. WARRANTY SERVICE LOG—This baaklet also contains a "Warranty Service Log" which should be kept up to date by your servicing dealer whenever warranty service is required on your vehicle. This will not only provide you with a record of such services but will also establish information for subsequent owners use.

TIRES

Tires or tubes are covered by the tire manufacturer's guarantee. While the guarantees of the various tire manufacturers vary in language, they provide in general that passenger car tires installed as original equipment at the factory are guaranteed to the owner to be free fram defects in material and workmanship for the life of the original tread as follows:

The tire manufacturer will repair the tire or tube without charge or make a pro rata allowance based on the amount of tread wear toward the purchase of a new tire or tube at current list price for any tire or tube which is found by the tire manufacturer to be defective. Transportation casts and taxes must be paid by the owner and service charges may be made in some instances.

In addition, for the first 24 months but during the tread life of the tire, passenger car tires are also guaranteed to the original purchaser in normal passenger car use against such occurrences as blowouts, fabric breaks, cuts, bruises, and snags, which in the opinion of the tire manufacturer renders the tire unserviceable. Damage from punctures, running flat, fire, wrecks, chain cuts, irregular wear, abuse, etc. are not covered. Adjustments under the 24 month guarantee are made in the same manner as those under the basic guarantee.

The above described tire guarantees are the only ones issued by the tire manufacturers, and they specifically provide that consequential damages are not covered by the guarantees. Your dealer will assist you in requesting an adjustment if this becomes necessary. If you request a passenger car tire adjustment under the 24 month guarantee, you should be prepared to show the delivery date of your car.

BATTERY

The Delca battery in your vehicle is covered against defects in material and workmanship under the terms of the New Vehicle Warranty for a periad of twenty-four (24) manths or twenty-four thousand (24,000) miles, whichever first accurs. The provisions which follow relating to battery service adjustments also apply to your Delco battery.

DELCO BATTERY SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS

For the purposes of these adjustments the following terms shall have the following meanings:

Adjusted Service Period—The period commencing with the expiration of the New Vehicle Warranty and expiring twenty-four (24) months (in the case of the Corvair) and thirty-six (36) months (in the case of all other Chevrolet passenger cars) from the date of delivery of the vehicle to the original purchaser if in normal passenger car use. (In the case of Corvair there will be an Adjusted Service Period only in the event the New Vehicle Warranty expires by mileage prior to 24 months from the date of sale to the original purchaser. For other types of passenger car use, such as taxicabs and palice cars, see your Chevrolet or Delco battery dealer to determine the Adjusted Service Period applicable to the Delco battery in your particular vehicle.)

Months of Service—The total months covered by both the New Vehicle Warranty and Adjusted Service Periods. The "months of service" commence to run on the date of delivery of the new vehicle by an authorized Chevrolet dealer to the original retail purchaser.

Undelivered Months of Service—The difference between the "months of service" and the months of actual service received.

Owner's Cost Per Month—The per month cost of the replaced battery to the owner determined by dividing the "months of service" into its current Delco battery manufacturer's suggested list price (or fleet owner's current cost).

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DELCO BATTERY SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS (Continued)

Should the Delco battery in your vehicle prove defective under normal car use within the Adjusted Service Period the defective battery can be exchanged for a new Delco battery of equal or greater capacity on an adjusted service (pro rata) basis at the place of business of an authorized Chevrolet dealer or Delco battery dealer. Credit toward the purchase of such new Delco battery will be equal to the "owner's cost per month" of the replaced battery multiplied by the number of "undelivered months of service".

Upon the expiration of the New Vehicle Warranty, the Adjusted Service Period opplies on a "months of service" basis only and mileage is not a factor. In no event is the date of installation of a replacement battery installed without charge pursuant to the New Vehicle Warranty used os the beginning date for the months of service.

The provisions of this Delco Battery Service Adjustments shall not apply (A) to failure in service due to misuse, negligence or accident, including but not limited to improper installation, freezing, failure to have battery inspected regularly and filled with colorless, odorless drinking water when needed, use of electrolyte other than "battery grade" sulphuric acid solution of a specific gravity recommended by Delco-Remy Division of General Motors Corporation, ar (B) to costs for recharging this battery or for the use of a rental battery.
